Please pay close attention to the abstract and paper guidelines.

Guideline for abstract preparation for the 5th Asian Population Association Conference

1. Abstract is required and should not exceed 200 words.
2. Extended abstract is optional and should not be more than 5 pages. The text is double-spaced; uses a 12-point font, and all illustrations, figures, and tables are placed within the text at the appropriate points, rather than at the end.
3. Full paper is optional. Length of the manuscript should not exceed 8,000 words excluding references (about 25 pages). The text is double-spaced; uses a 12-point font; and all illustrations, figures, and tables are placed within the text at the appropriate points, rather than at the end.
4. The paper title **must not be in 'all capital letters'** (e.g. 'INFLUENCE OF PARENTAL EDUCATION ON NUPTIAL BEHAVIOR: AN ANALYSIS OF HINDU COMMUNITY IN INDIA' must be 'Influence of Parental Education on Nuptial Behavior: An Analysis of Hindu Community in India').
5. The authors' names **must not be in 'all capital letters'** (e.g. 'SAM SMITH' must be 'Sam SMITH').

We are looking forward to receiving your abstracts and welcoming you to Yogyakarta, Indonesia, in November 2020.
